Northeastern State University is Oklahoma's premier regional university and the state's fourth largest university. NSU was recently named 'Best Regional University' by Oklahoma Living Magazine readers. NSU Broken Arrow continues to grow by leaps and bounds. The student enrollment for Spring 2008 was 3100 plus. Since the campus opened in 2001, they have tripled enrollment.

RHEMA hosts 10-12 different events every year, drawing from about 2500 people (Winter Bible Seminar and Campmeeting) to over 20,000 (Rockets over RHEMA) and RHEMA's biggest event (annual Christmas Lights' display) with over 200,000 visitors every year. In addition there are frequent seminars such as the annual Women's and Men's Conference that attract between 1500 and 3000 attendees as well as College Weekends for RHEMA Bible Training Center with average attendees of over 300.
